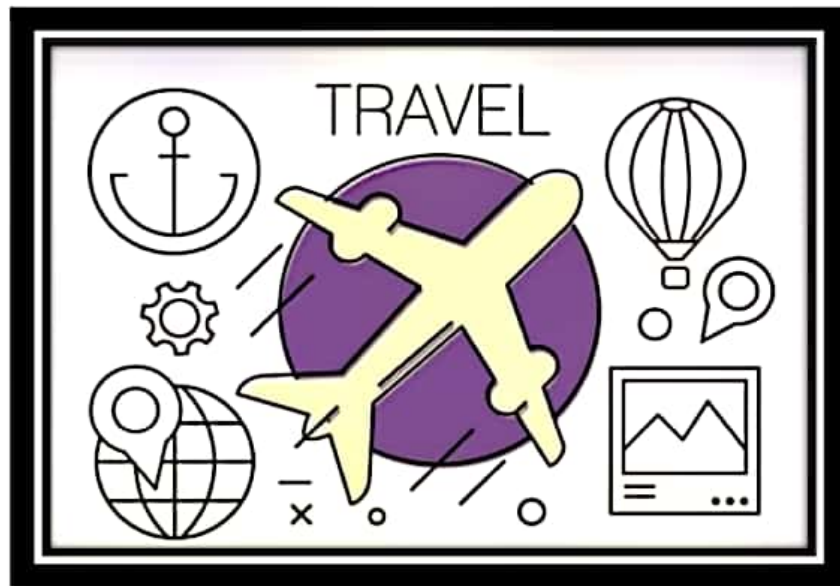

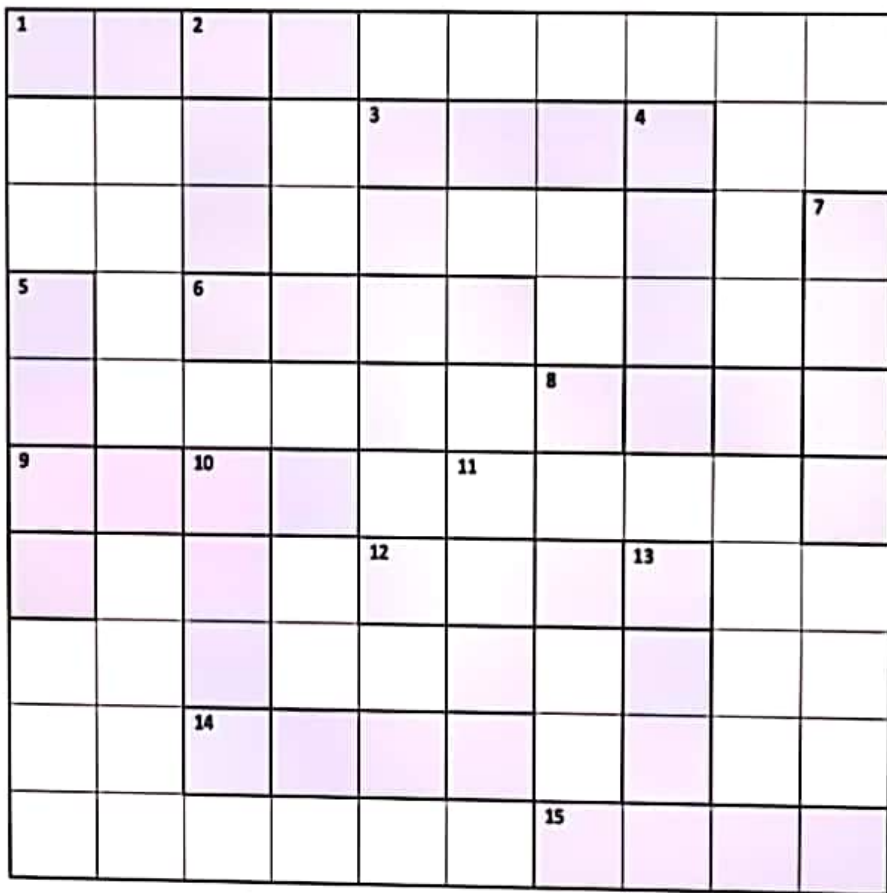

Wildlife Warriors: Unite for Endangered Animals

An endangered species is a type of organism that is threatened by extinction. The animals that face the threat of extinction are known as endangered animals. Some of the examples of endangered animals are **tigers, pandas, whales, and rhinoceros**. The endangered animals of Madhya Pradesh are **black buck, elephants, crocodiles, pangolin, vultures etc.** The endangered animals of Bihar are **ganges river dolphin known as "susu", Indian skimmer etc.** The major reasons for the loss of population of these animals are loss of habitat, change in climate, poaching. loss of habitat can happen naturally. Nonavian dinosaurs, for instance, lost their habitat about 65 million years ago. Individuals can play a significant role in protecting endangered species and their habitats through various actions.
